

## Plan of Study

The program requires completion of a minimum of 30 graduate credit hours to earn a non-thesis Master of Science in Biology degree. All courses are offered at The University of Toledo campus. ## Scholarship

*IMPACT* scholarships cover ALL costs to earn a Master of Science, a value of over \$15,000. Scholarships pay for tuition, fees, parking, course books and materials. Scholars are awarded with a two-year membership to SECO (Science Education Council of Ohio).

## Eligibility

Only ten *IMPACT* scholarships are available to Toledo Public School science teachers in grades 4-12. Scholars must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. Be a U.S. citizen.
- 2. Qualify for Ohio residency.
- 3. Be accepted to the Graduate School and the Department of Environmental Sciences (DES) at The University of Toledo. This requires a minimum combined **GRE**

score of 1050 and a 2.7 G.P.A. from a previous degree including one year of chemistry and one year of biology.
